- Reply: (1) The Drainage Services Department will conduct a flood hazard study for the purpose of investigating, assessing and mitigating flood hazards in the squatter areas in 2004-05. In support of the study, the Housing Department will conduct site inspections and surveys to ascertain the actual number of squatter structures and population involved and verify the accuracy of location maps and drawings. The Housing Department will also assist in setting up a database for updating information on squatter areas.
 - (2) The additional workload arising from compilation of squatter information will be absorbed within the existing staff establishment and budget provision of the Housing Department.
