Reply: The reference to the 659 posts to be deleted by Housing Department by

March 2007, as stated in SHPL's speech at the Special FC meeting on 11 April, covers all Housing Department staff, including those funded by the Government for squatter control duties (and charged to Head 62 of the Government's General Revenue Account) as well as those funded by the

Housing Authority.

40 of these 659 posts are surplus posts in the squatter control programme area funded under Head 62. Of these, 35 will be deleted in 2005-06. The remaining five posts, which are among the 398 surplus posts under Head 62, will be deleted by March 2007.
